Health insurance is not only a smart idea for international students to have, but it can protect you from financial burden if an unexpected illness/injury should happen. Most students are young and healthy and will rarely have medical issues. However, it's a smart idea to have a comprehensive medical plan in place to protect you.

In the past NDAA has strongly suggested that each international student obtains health insurance to provide for care in the event of accident or illness. It is now a **requirement** to have health insurance for entire school year. **Proof of this insurance** in the form of **an insurance card** will need to be on record with NDAA **by September 15, 2017** to maintain enrollment at NDAA.

The health and welfare of each international student is of the utmost importance to the North Dallas Adventist Academy. Please assist us in verifying that your child/ward has the required coverage by providing us with a copy of your insurance card **by the September 15 deadline**. We appreciate your cooperation.
