STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

This code of conduct is to ensure the safe passage of students under contract of North Dallas Adventist Academy. It has been written to ensure that drivers understand their responsibilities within the terms of the contract and to ensure that they and their passengers have a safe and comfortable journey. The following guidelines are just a summary of what is expected. All students are required to adhere to the guidelines of the NDAA student handbook while riding on the transportation van.

Code of Conduct for Student:

- Student must be on-time
- Student must wear seat belts at ALL TIMES in the vehicle.
- Student may text or call ahead to parents to give approximate time of arrival if need be.
- Any guest of the student must be authorized IN ADVANCE by school administration before they are allowed to be transported (after school/weekends)
- Student understands that the driver is an official representative of NDAA and that they must abide by directions or instructions given by the driver.
- Student must avoid any swearing or making remarks that are personal, sexual, racist, and/or profane.
- Student shall not damage or deface the van
- Student will not be allowed consumption of food/and or beverages.
- Student must avoid any type of physical contact.
- Student must avoid all activity that would distract the driver (ex: horseplay, shouting, etc.)
- Student is prohibited from going through another passenger's personal belongings.
- Student must not be left unattended at any pick up or drop off location (by neither parent or driver).
