Dear Parents, Guardians and Students,

As you may be aware, our school has had several instances of “high risk” COVID-19 exposures in the past 10 days. Following the current school COVID-19 policy, more than half of our student body have been consequently sent into quarantine.

After careful consideration, prayer, and discussion with our Medical Advisory, the school policy has been revised to include the requirement of face masks for students, teachers and staff, effective immediately. As a school administration, we must carefully consider the safety of the entire student body and the impact of COVID-19 quarantining on the ability for our students to be in school learning. While we in no way wish to infringe on your family’s personal health choices, we have made the decision to minimize as many risk factors at school as are possible, which includes masking on campus, among other things. When all individuals are masked, it takes any exposures to “Low Risk” and would not necessitate quarantine, even if one of the individuals is lab-confirmed to have COVID-19.

We appreciate your support and prayers for the Lord’s continued guidance. Schooling during an ever-changing pandemic is full of challenges and fears. Yet we know He is “with us always” (Matthew 28:20b).
